HARALD NAEGELI - The Zurich Sprayer, alias Harry Cloud (Harry Wolke) Born 4 December 1939 in Zurich

1956-64	Studies at the Zurich School of Applied Arts, then at the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris. Collages, woodcuts and drawings.
1977	First graffiti in Tessin, later also in Zurich. Harald Naegeli operates for two years as a »phantom sprayer«.
1979	Reward of 3000 CHF offered for the »Zurich Sprayer«. Arrested in June.
1980	Extends his spray actions also to include Cologne (Cologne Dance of Death), Berlin, Düsseldorf, Frankfurt and Stuttgart.
1981	After a scuffle with the police, Harald Naegeli flees Switzerland via Italy to Germany.
1982	The Kölnischer Kunstverein presents a photo documentation of the »Cologne Dance of Death«, and an international arrest warrant is issued.
1984	In April, Harald Naegeli gives himself up to the Basel frontier police, accompanied by Klaus Staeck and Joseph Beuys. He spends four months in Winterthur prison and two months in open detention in a correction facility in Wauwilermoos, Lucerne.
1986	Harald Naegeli reacts to the Sandoz chemical spill into the Rhine at Schweizerhalle with his » <i>Dance of Death</i> of the dead fish«.
1987	Spray actions in Venice against animal experimentation and pollution from cruise ships.
1990	Exhibitions in the Kunstmuseum Düsseldorf and the Staatsgalerie Stuttgart. Harald Naegeli works increasingly on paper.
1991	Start of his »Urwolken« (primal clouds).

1993	Exhibition in the Kunsthaus Zürich with a spray performance.
2004	Restoration of »Undine« (1978) at Zurich University and the start of his correspondence with Zurich's Grossmünster concerning his proposal for the Dance of Death project inside the two church towers.
2010	Benefit action in support of ProNatura in Zurich as well as an exhibition in the Cologne Zoo in aid of animal protection.
2014	Solo exhibition in the European Academy of Fine Arts in Trier.
2016	Solo exhibition »The Trial« in the Stadtmuseum Düsseldorf.
2017	Harald Naegeli donates works to the Prints and Drawings Collection Tübingen, to the Kunstmuseum Bonn and the Stadtmuseum Bonn, to the Schnütgen-Museum in Cologne and the Stadtmuseum Düsseldorf.
2018	Work starts on the Dance of Death in the Grossmünster but its completion is prohibited by the church's governing council.
2020	Harald Naegeli leaves Düsseldorf and returns to Zurich. The »Wolkegabe Action«: Harald Naegeli donates 50 original drawings to property owners who during the first Covid-19 lockdown waived the rents of commercial tenants. Zurich Dance of Death from April to June.
	Awarded the Zurich City Art Award in September.
2021	Solo exhibition »The Known Unknown« in the Musée Visionnaire in Zurich.
2022	Exhibition »Harald Naegeli in Cologne«, Schnütgen Museum, starting in March 2022.
